
What is Philosophy?

Logic

concerns the relational structures between statements or other elements


Ethics

discusses how we should act, "what is the right thing to do?"



Aesthetics

what is beauty? what is art and what is its function?



Social Theory


discusses how societies function/interact



Metaphysics

what is the nature of reality? what is everything made out of?

The metaphysics of human persons- what is a human being? If I am just the matter I am made up of, how am I the *same* person I was 20 years ago?



Epistemology

the study of knowledge itself

When can we say that we (or say, an AI) *know* something?



Where/when did this begin?
